





My home is in Royds Road. My background is mainly Local Government; initially at Folkestone Council starting in 1961, I came to Ashford in 1967 to work for the Council as an accountant and ended up staying 29 years! I also worked as an Auditor and a Contract Manager for the Council until I retired early. I then spent 11 years working for a private bank.

In 2007, when I was asked to stand for election, I totally retired from work so that I was able to devote the necessary time to undertake the role of a Councillor effectively. I have been a Councillor for 12 years, which, together with my work time, gives me 46 years Local Government experience.

The Ward may be newly formed but many of the issues we face are familiar:

- Another Newtown Road closure will push diverted traffic into the Willesborough area for up to 10 weeks.
- Further development likely; on the Klondyke and Newtown Works area.
- Continuing concerns about increasing the number of Houses in Multiple Occupation (HMO) on the Evolution and Bushy Royds estates, creating too high a demand for car parking.
- The impact of the opening of Junction 10A and future development along the A20 on traffic flowing through our roads.
- Awareness that managing water flows in our Ward is vital - the Aylesford stream will flood if new development changes do not prepare for ground water run off.
